Phuket Has Been Good To Us Foundation is a Thai registered charity that provides English lessons for FREE to over 600 disadvantaged Thai children in 2 Government schools in Phuket.

Our goal is to form a partnership with InterContinental Phuket Resort to enable us to continue to support our students as well as provide beneficial exposure for your business through networking, fundraisers and social media.

Who We Are

Our five fully-qualified English teachers provide English education for FREE to over 600 underprivileged Thai children in Phuket. We teach English to students aged 3 to 12 as well as Maths and Science in English to children aged 7 to 11.

200 children stay in dormitories at Kamala School because they are unable to live at home as they are orphans or their families are not able to look after them. To give these children nurturing support, our teachers and volunteers run Coconut Club, an after-school programme where the children can come to do arts & crafts, play games, learn cooking and practice their English.

Sponsor our Senior Teacher, Jerlin Balais for a year 750,000thb

To cover her visa, work permit, salary, teaching equipment and supplies.

Teacher Jerlin has been teaching for the Foundation for over 3 years. As Senior Teacher, Jerlin creates the entire curriculum for English and Maths & Science in English for levels Kindergarten to Primary 6. In addition to developing the curriculum and supporting the other teachers, she is also the full time Science in English Teacher for Primary levels 3-5 and the full time English Teacher for Primary 4 and 6.

In addition to teaching full time, our Senior Teacher also:

- Provides guidance and assists the teaching team with their class and teaching needs/concerns
- Designs and reviews the curriculum for all classes taught by PHBGTU, including English classes and Maths and Science classes in English (also known as EIS).
- Coordinates with the school to ensure efficient and effective running of PHBGTU programmes (English, EIS and Coconut Club).
- Explores further opportunities for students to learn.
- Conducts evaluation of the EIS programme and English in both schools we support.



Sponsor our Teacher, Hamant Singh for a year 460,000thb

To cover his visa, work permit, salary, teaching equipment and supplies.

Teacher Hamant is entering his 3rd year teaching for the Foundation and has over 8 years of professional teaching experience. He teaches English classes for Primary levels 1-5 and Science in English to Primary levels 1 and 2.

Teacher Hamant's responsibilities include:

- Developing fun and engaging lessons, like introducing a class fish or having students pot their own plants.
- Assessing students' progress inside and outside of the classroom, updating classroom focus as needed.
- Helping out every Saturday with swimming lessons for the residential students.
- Hosting Coconut Club every Tuesday.



Sponsor our Teacher, Esra Dolot for a year 460,000thb

To cover her visa, work permit, salary, travel to Kalim School and teaching supplies.



Teacher Esra is in her second year of teaching with us, taking on the P1-P6 English classes at Kalim school. She also teaches our Kindy students at Kamala school 2 days a week.

Teacher Esra's responsibilities include:

- Creating lesson plans modified for Thai students' learning English as a second language
- Teaching the students basic English skills such as listening, reading, writing and speaking skills
- Planning classroom activities that inspire students to appreciate and develop their love of learning a foreign language
- Hosting Bingo/Arts and Crafts at Coconut Club every Wednesday

Teacher Yulya Sorokina, kindly sponsored by Phuket Condos & Homes since 2015

Yulya joined Phuket Has Been Good To Us as a volunteer teacher in November 2015, moving to a full-time, salaried position in May 2016. She currently teaches English to students in Primary year 2 through to Primary year 6.

Teacher Yulya's responsibilities include:

- Developing lesson plans for primary year 2 to 6 English classes.
- Assisting the teaching team with Mathematics in English classes.
- Utilising recreational activities to encourage character development.
- Hosting Arts and Crafts/Games at Coconut Club every Thursday.



Teacher Jeslynn Loo, P3 EIS Class kindly Sponsored by MontAzure since 2018



Teacher Jeslynn has been working with us for almost 2 years. Her extensive background in student development and programme coordination has brought many successful projects to the table. Jeslynn teaches our Kindy students, along with Mathematics in English classes for our P1-P5 students.

Teacher Jeslynn's responsibilities include:

- Researching and implementing new ideas and activities into the classroom to maintain student curiosity and excitement for learning.
- Assessing students' performances through classwork, group activities, educational games and final exams.
- Introducing nutritious cooking recipes for students to try during Monday afternoons at Coconut Club, where she hosts a weekly cooking club.

Sponsor our Thai Office Manager, Arporn Nortip for a year 400,000thb
To cover her salary, travel expenses and office supplies.

Khun Arporn Nortip, who comes from a teaching background, has been the Office Manager for PHBGTU since 2013. Khun Arporn liaises with the Thai directors and teachers at the government schools we support and also enables us to communicate with Thai speakers in the community. She manages our relationships with Government bodies and recently secured PHBGTU membership of the prestigious M Society, which highlights that we work in Phuket for the good of the Thai community.

Graham has lived in Phuket for over ten years, during which time he has been a dedicated volunteer with Phuket Has Been Good To Us. During his time with PHBGTU, Graham has also set a Guinness World Record whilst raising a million baht for the Foundation and has organised a party on a Super Yacht which raised 500,000 baht.
